## Lion Lunch Buddy Program Guidelines



1. Mentors work under the direction and supervision of school staff.
2. Mentors may not supervise a class in the teacher's absence.
3. Mentors are required to maintain strict confidentiality and agree to comply in writing.
4. Mentors are expected to meet with Mentor Coordinator for monthly review.
5. Mentors may not take students off-campus during the day.
6. Gift-giving is discouraged.
7. Mentors may have up to (2) student mentees.
8. Mentors may not bring in food for students.
9. Mentors should never bring any children with them while mentoring.

### Lion Lunch Buddies must:

- Be willing to make a one-year commitment to come to lunch once a week on a regular basis.
- Have the ability and desire to spend time with elementary age children.
- Have an understanding and appreciation of the challenges faced by many children today.
- Be willing to respect the confidentiality of your relationship with a child.
- Be prepared to have fun and enjoy the company of a new friend!
